Slightly gummy, lots of raspberry, blackcurrant & smoke notes. Classic Fleurie & wonderful softness
- 35. Regolo Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso £34**
Sartori, Veneto, Italy 2015
Intense and persistent aromas; on the palate, full bodied, dry, velvety, with black-cherry flavour and dried fruit on the lingering finish.
- 36. Syrah La Vigne d'à Côté, Cuilleron £35**
Rhone, France
Crushed blackcurrant, black pepper & leathery notes with a big palate of fresh raspberries, cherries, dark blackberry & cracked pepper flavours.
- 37. Chianti Classico Riserva DOCG, Castellani £35**
Tuscany, Italy 2013
Traditional style Chianti, intense & characteristic bouquet, earthy, wild red berries & underwood notes. Harmonious, savoury, strong and persistent
- 38. Pinot Noir Las Brisas Vineyard, £36**
Leyda Valley, Chile 2016
Aromatically fresh & complex, handpicked grapes & aged in French oak for 10 months, intense aromas of black cherry, raspberries & hints of wild herbs & earth. Great exponent of Pinot Noir

Vignobles Dubard, Bordeaux, France 2015
The well-integrated tannins first offer a silky palate to reveal afterwards altogether a dense structure & fresh mouth with liquorice & fruits of the forest aromas.

Bordeaux, France 2016
Classy Bordeaux with great structure & body. Aged in selected oak barrels giving it a subtle cherry oak flavours, with hints of vanilla & smoke.
- 42. Barbaresco Basarin, Negro £49**
Piemonte, Italy 2014
One of the noble wines of Piemonte with long velvety finish, red fruits, hints of violet, cedar & oak
- 43. Amarone Della Valpolicella Valpantena, £65**
BERTANI, Veneto, Italy, 2015

CHAMPAGNE

1. **NV Brut Baron De Marck, JM Gobillard et Fils, Champagne, France** £35
A pure, limpid and soft champagne with stylish character. Its fruit is fresh and appealing, bursting with apples & lemons. An uplifting note of freshly baked brioche adds complexity and class to an elegantly balanced palate.
4. **NV Rose Brut, JM Gobillard et Fils, Hautfillers, Champagne, France** £45
Juicy ripe red fruits on the nose, good body and structure in the mouth and a long elegant finish
5. **Taittinger Brut Reserve NV** £55
From Champagne's oldest cellars, this Champagne has peach & acacia notes on the nose, citrus-yet delicately honeyed palate with an elegant finish.
6. **Ruinart NV** £75
One of the oldest Champagne houses, founded in 1729, Ruinart was the first house to export Champagne which was sought-after & hard to come by. Elegant & subtle: one of the jewels in the Champagne crown

46. **Hutton Ridge Pinotage Rosé, Coastal Region, South Africa** £20
Full to bursting with fresh strawberry & ripe cherry characters. Light & refreshing
47. **Voluta Pinot Grigio Rose, Veneto, Italy** £23
It has freshness, delicacy & rose-scented charm all the way through, with red cherry & strawberry fruit & a dry finish.
48. **Comte de Provence Rosé, La Vidabanaise, France** £27
Classic light pink in the glass. A light, bright nose of wild strawberries. Refreshing and smooth on the palate. Moreish finish. Soft acidity & delicate juiciness.
